



PATIENT INFORMATION FOR NUCLEAR MEDICINE PROCEDURES

CANCELLATION	These test procedures require the use of specially prepared nuclear isotopes which are ordered the day prior to testing. If cancellation becomes necessary, notify the office as soon as possible. 24 Hour Cancellation Notice, Monday through Friday, is required. OTHERWISE THE PATIENT MUST BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COST OF THE ISOTOPE, \$160.
ATTIRE	All clothing should be comfortable and loose fitting. Wear slacks or shorts and comfortable walking shoes, preferably sneakers or tennis shoes.
MEALS	No heavy meals for 4 hours prior to testing.
SMOKING	Preferably no smoking 2 hours prior to testing.
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES	NO alcoholic beverages the day of the test.
NOTE	Please avoid the use of bath soaps that contain oil, baby lotions or powders.
FEES	Payment of service fees are due and payable in full at the time of service unless otherwise prearranged with our business office.

NUCLEAR STUDY

The **Nuclear Study** is performed in conjunction with an exercise tolerance test. During this test a radioisotope will be injected into an arm vein. You will then be placed under a state of the art camera that photographically maps the pattern of blood flow to your heart muscle. You are scheduled for:

- Adenosine/Myoview/Thallium
- Myoview/Thallium
- Myoview/Myoview

ADENOSINE THALLIUM

DO NOT drink or eat anything that contains caffeine the day of your test. You may be walking on the treadmill (without incline) for this test.
